- The above trading holidays are set based on the Joint Ministerial Decree (SKB) of the Minister of Religious Affairs No. 5 Year 2014, the Minister of Manpower and Transmigration No. 3/SKB/MEN/V/2014 and the State Ministry for State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucracy Reformation of Republic of Indonesia No. 02/SKB/MENPAN/V/2014 regarding National Holidays and Public Leaves 2015.
- Birth of the Prophet Muhammad SAW 1436 H (3 January 2015), Hindu Saka New Year 1937 (21 March 2015), Isra' Mi'raj of the prophet Muhammad SAW (16 May 2015), and Commemoration of led ul-Fitr 1436 Hijriyah (18 July 2015) Holidays are not mentioned in the above list because they fall on Saturday or Sunday.
- December 9, 2015 is set as a trading holiday according to the Republic of Indonesia Presidential Decree Number 25 of 2015 regarding Voting Day of the Elections of Governor and Vice Governor, Regent and Vice Regent, also Mayor and Deputy Mayor Year 2015 as National Holiday.
- Beside as mentioned above, a trading holiday can be announced later if Bank Indonesia decides to close all clearing activities or if the Indonesian Government announces another public holiday.
